ESB calls for redesign of Australian energy market

The Energy Security Board has released its Post 2025 [Market Design Consultation Paper](#) in which it has outlined its vision for the Australian energy market in 2025 and beyond. The paper was developed in collaboration with the Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) the Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO) and the Australian Energy Regulator (AER), and is focused on making the national electricity market fit for purpose.

Decarbonised steel making moves a step closer
