### **The Australian government's cybersecurity bark is worse than its bite**

The Australian government's cybersecurity bark is worse than its bite, with a new [report](#) finding its intentions in cyber is not yet being matched by actual capability. The National Cyber Power Index 2020, created by the Harvard Kennedy School's Belfer Center for Science and International Affairs, measured 30 countries in terms of cyber capabilities.
