Thousands of jobs to be created on Toyota site with higher density development proposal

The buyer of the Toyota site at Woolooware Bay forecasts the new business park it is planning will create thousands of jobs, with strong interest already fielded from global and national brands. This will require higher density development across the site through a long-term masterplan, which can be sought under the present B7 zoning.

Local Strategy Planning Statement is official and now available
