## **Synroc set to be commercialised**

The Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation (ANSTO) has announced that the construction of its [Synroc radioactive treatment building](#) is complete, with processing equipment now being installed, ahead of it being commissioned prior to operations in 2025. ANSTO has been attempting to commercialise its Synroc method of encapsulating radioactive wastes into a durable solid wastefrom for decades, with the latest development coming as 'international interest is building' in the technology according to ANSTO.

## **Australia's first advanced computer manufacturing facility**

**Backed by the department of defence, SoftIron has officially opened Australia's first component-level [IT infrastructure manufacturing facility](#) in a step closer towards developing sovereign capability in critical technology. SoftIron's Sydney facility is an advanced manufacturing hub that produces ICT componentry for SoftIron's groundbreaking [HyperCloud Intelligent Cloud Fabric](#), the world's first complete technology for building clouds.**

## **New technology by UTS to reduce potholes**

[University of Technology Sydney](#) researchers have developed new '[intelligent compaction](#)' technology, which integrates into a road roller and can assess in real-time the quality of road base compaction. Improved road construction can thus reduce potholes and maintenance costs, and lead to safer, more resilient roads. The study was led by Associate Professor Behzad Fatahi, head of geotechnical and transport engineering, together with Professor Hadi Kahbbaz, Dr Di Wu and PhD student Zhengheng Xu.

## **Veggie waste offers a green solution to the single-use plastic problem**

Australia's looming single-use plastic problem could soon shrink with recent developments in bioplastic. Researchers from Victoria University – with support from the Victorian government – have been working on developing [sustainable package solutions](#) made from agricultural waste such as peas, lettuce, celery, and mushrooms.
