Free CSIRO program to benefit advanced manufacturing SMEs

Small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) working on new advanced manufacturing solutions can sign up for CSIRO's 10-week online Innovate to Grow program, to support their idea by building their R&D knowledge. Upon completion of

the program, eligible participants may have the opportunity to access facilitation support, through CSIRO, to connect to research expertise nationally, along with dollar-matched R&D funding. The program, commencing 10 August, is available for up to 25 SMEs. Applications close on 17 July 2023.

My Business: Small Business Granted Tax Amnesty

The Australian Taxation Office (ATO) is encouraging small businesses that have overdue income tax returns, fringe benefits tax returns or business activity statements to take advantage of a new amnesty to get their lodgments back on track. The amnesty was announced in the 2023-24 Budget. It applies to tax obligations that were originally due between 1 December 2019 and 28 February 2022 and runs from 1 June 2023 to 31 December 2023.

WEHI's professor Doug Hilton appointed as CSIRO chief executive

The Board of Directors of CSIRO, Australia's national science agency, has appointed Professor Doug Hilton, AO, as chief executive, commencing on 29 September 2023. Professor Hilton is a molecular and cellular biologist and Director

of the Walter and Eliza Hall Institute of Medical Research (WEHI). For the past 14 years, under his direction, WEHI has grown to become a multidisciplinary organisation that makes fundamental discoveries and works with partners to translate these into improved outcomes in cancer, infectious and immune diseases, developmental disorders and diseases of ageing.
