Industry and government launch Infrastructure Net Zero initiative

The Australian Constructors Association has joined forces with other private sector peak bodies and federal agencies to launch the 'Infrastructure Net Zero' joint initiative. Australian Constructors Association CEO Jon Davies said the initiative underscores the close collaboration between government and industry in creating a clear path for the sector to reach net zero emissions. Visy unveiled a major \$42.5 million upgrade to its paper recycling and remanufacturing campus in <u>Coolaroo</u> with Premier Daniel Andrews and Federal Minister for the Environment and Water, Tanya Plibersek. <u>The upgrade</u> is part of Visy Executive Chairman Anthony Pratt's commitment to invest \$2 billion over the next decade to reduce landfill, cut emissions and create thousands of green collar Australian manufacturing jobs.

Food fraud is costing the Australian economy a staggering \$3 billion each year, according to a report from AgriFutures.
