Business NSW: NSW Budget 2023-2024 Analysis

The NSW Government must be commended for following through on their promise of no new business taxes. Key business measures announced in the budget: An additional \$800m injection of funds into the Transmission Acceleration Facility to speed up energy transition. Creating the \$1billion Energy Security Corporation to deliver additional firming support to backup renewables; \$112m for a thorough VET review and additional funding to fund the TAFE funding shortfall; \$4.9b to build 43 schools and upgrading a further 86, which will be built by NSW businesses.

CSIRO Snapshot Sept 2023

With Australia now in an El Niño climate pattern, we are supporting industries and communities to prepare for impacts on marine ecosystems. Forecasting suggests above-average ocean temperatures are likely to occur around Australia this summer. We're working with the Bureau of Meteorology to prepare fisheries and aquaculture industries for the potential impacts of marine heatwaves. Some of the more severe impacts might include coral bleaching, altered aquaculture yields, and changes in wild fish migration patterns.
