As we seek to move towards 3% of GDP as a measure of the R&D in the economy, we are assuming that simply increasing the percentage will increase the output, in some sort of linear manner. Ranking as we do at 93 in the world in the Harvard Atlas of Economic Complexity, squeezed between Uganda on 92 and Pakistan at 94, we need to do something different. Have we asked the question: what changes need to be made to the multi-jurisdictional, fragmented and short-term focused system we have

currently.

Global construction industry trends: Al, sustainability and inclusion

Dr Gretchen Gagel shares insights from her <u>collaborative study on global</u> <u>construction</u> industry trends, exploring the current landscape of artificial intelligence, sustainability and inclusion. In February 2024, I once again had the opportunity to share the results of a global study conducted with the US-based Construction User Roundtable (CURT) on key challenges and associated solutions in the construction industry. I initiated this study back in the 90s because I wanted to understand what was keeping industry leaders awake at night and what they saw as critical opportunities to improve our industry

Don't pay for government information. It's available for free

When you start to look for government grants to support your business, you may find fraudulent websites and services that claim to provide access to grants information. All available government <u>grant information</u> can be accessed for free through official government sources, so don't get caught out by a scam!
