#### Interim Report on Grocery Codes calls for harsher penalties

The interim report of the Review of the voluntary Food and Grocery Code of Conduct was released yesterday (8 April). Independent Reviewer Dr Craig Emerson announced eight firm recommendations, including that the Code be made mandatory, with penalties of \$10 million or more for serious breaches. The Report makes a further three recommendations on which stakeholder views are sought.
