AsiaLink: *Doing business in Indonesia Program* On-line 1st May 1-3 pm

Indonesia is an emerging Asian giant. It is the largest economy in Southeast Asia and steady growth continues on the back of open trade and investment policies and increasing domestic consumption. <u>Indonesia's proximity</u> and emerging global market economy present significant opportunities for Australian enterprise. Yet Indonesia remains at an earlier stage of development than some of its neighbours, making it a more challenging place to do business.

While lacking detail at this stage, the significance of Prime Minister Albanese's Future Made in Australia announcement should not be underestimated. It is a timely recognition at the highest levels of government that 'old orthodoxies' have failed to shift the dial on stalled productivity, wage stagnation and energy transition. The proposed legislation will not just be a tidy-up but a <u>major change</u> in the way Australia does innovation and industrial policy.
