Why increasing annual leave is on the table for Australia

Five weeks <u>annual leave</u> is an idea whose time may have come. A decade ago, a Productivity Commission <u>inquiry into Australia's industrial relations system</u>, recommended governments periodically "examine whether there are any grounds for extending the existing 20 days of paid annual leave". Now, with the <u>Shop Distributive and Allied Employees Association</u> pushing for an extra week of annual leave for 1.3 million retail and fast food workers, the issue may be about to get a serious hearing.

# **CLINUVEL product studied for Sun exposure DNA repair**

Biopharmaceurical company CLINUVEL has announced results from a study evaluating the DNA-repair capacity of its <u>afamelanotide product</u> on skin of healthy volunteers exposed to ultraviolet (UV) radiation. The study, conducted at Salford Royal Hospital, Manchester suggests that afamelanotide leads to reduction of differentially expressed genes (DEGs) in exposed skin, according to an ASX announcement.
