Business NSW – NSW Budget 24-25

Includes: \$1.5 billion tax increase on business & landlords; s further \$5 million for the NSW Business Bureau; Extension of the Energy Bill Relief Fund, Fee-free training for apprentices and trainees will continue; \$650 million for essential worker housing; \$\$201.9 million for housing infrastructure in the regions and nightlife and live events boosted with \$54 million.

Local content a factor in Illawarra wind turbine construction

The use of <u>local components</u> and wider economic benefits to the community will be key considerations in Climate Change and Energy Minister Chris Bowen's selection of companies to construct Australia's new offshore wind farms. Bowen made the commitment talking at BlueScope Steel's Port Kembla plant after announcing the declaration of an offshore wind production zone off the Illawarra coast in New South Wale

Stronger business and government investment, population growth and budget positions have seen Australia record its <u>best international competitiveness</u> ranking since 2011. The nation rose from 19th to 13th in the IMD World Competitiveness Yearbook 2024, a global ranking of the competitiveness of 67 nations released today. Australia's Competitiveness Profile here.

Business failures have surged to levels not seen before as deteriorating economic

conditions combined with poor consumer spending and stubborn inflationary pressures, including higher operating expenses, damage the fortunes of many companies. And insolvency experts expect the number of company failures may not slow until the Reserve Bank announces interest rate relief.
