CSIRO Snapshot: Australian homes are getting more energy efficient

CEDA: Structural change reveals cracks in our economic foundations
It comes as no surprise that many of the <u>policy issues</u> identified in the dashboard are playing out in current policy debate and commentary. This includes key strengths, like our independent central bank and our high workforce participation rate, confirmed again in the latest labour force data, which also showed a rise in the unemployment rate. But important weaknesses we identified have also been front and centre including, importantly, education outcomes, fiscal sustainability and the impact of population ageing on care services and funding.

The NSW Government has announced the delivery of its commitment to a \$2.3 million funding boost for the Industry Capability Network (ICN) NSW. ICN supports businesses by linking them to projects and manufacturers and improving their supply chain opportunities. The organisation recently celebrated its 40th anniversary at Parliament House, Canberra demonstrating its long-term commitment to supporting small-medium enterprise in particular to secure work in private and public sector procurement.
