Signs of improvement' within the industry, major survey finds The quarterly ACCI–Westpac Survey of Industrial Trends has found <u>signs of</u> <u>improvement</u> in conditions among manufacturers, though the general business outlook from companies for the next six months, while improved, "remains deeply pessimistic". A summary of the survey, which has been running since 1966, notes that national accounts figures indicate the Australian economy remaining in the slow lane. Manufacturers are, however, "finding some pockets of demand". The survey came out with an Actual Composite improving to 56 from 54.6 in the June quarter, with 50 indicating the breakeven threshold.
