Some SME-centric solutions for lagging technology adoption

As this publication has noted before, one of the defining features of manufacturing in this nation is the <u>large number of small companies</u>. And while we regularly note the SMEs' entrepreneurial streak and contributions to progress, being of a certain size comes with its limitations. SMEs spend 24 per cent more on R&D than large companies, and such manufacturers are among the most likely to innovate, notes researcher Dilupa Nakandala in a recent paper. They also lag in adopting new technologies, and suffer a big list of hurdles to remedying this and therefore shoring up their resilience.
